The age is determined as at 31 December 2023. The age of the youngest registered team member determines which age category the team will compete in.

If there are insufficient number of entries in an age category, categories may be combined in order to conduct a good quality competition. The awarding of medals will



not be affected, meaning that individuals will still be awarded medals in the age category in which they originally entered.

Lake Kaukajärvi is a freshwater lake about 7 km east of the city centre. It extends to a length of 3 km. At its broadest it is about 800 m wide and at its deepest almost 30 m deep. The total surface area of the lake is around 1.5 km2. The competition lanes are in clear water without any currents.

LAUNCHING AND LANDING

At the western end of the lake there is one platform for the launching and another platform for the landing.

AREAS FOR THE PUBLIC

In the immediate vicinity of the finish line, there are seats for approximately 550 people and, in addition to that, other premises for the public with space for over 1,000 people. A kiosk



COMPETITION DETAILS

Competition rules

Sprint Competition Standard:

Lane width will be 9 meters and there will be nine lines. Only one competitor per lane is permitted.

Only racing boats that comply with international sprint canoe/kayak rules are admitted: K1, K2, K4, C1, C2.

Medals

In European Masters Games, the athletes do not represent their country of origin, therefore the prize-awarding ceremonies will be carried out without hoisting of flags. No National Anthem of the winning team will be played. The medals will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

Technical meeting

A Technical Meeting will take place before the start of the competitions in order to introduce the competitions, remind those involved of the regulations and the behavior that is expected.

Personal accident insurance and medical certificate

It is the participant's own responsibility to take out adequate and valid accident and health insurance. The competitor registration fee does not cover personal accident insurance.

Anti-doping

The IMGA has adopted an anti-doping policy in line with the WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency) code, which means that testing will be conducted during the games. Each participant must comply with and independently consent to the IMGA Anti-Doping policy

EQUIPMENT

Sprint Equipment

Competitors are recommended to bring their own boats, paddles and personal flotation devices or consult with boat manufacturers for possible rental equipment.

Boats numbers will be provided by organizing committee, and will be required to be checked out and in

Individuals are responsible for the safekeeping and storage of their own equipment.

The Organizing Committee may suggest all or certain individuals to wear flotation devices in case of bad weather or water conditions.

UNIFORMS

The Organizing Committee will not distribute sportswear for the dispute of the competitions.

Matching team uniforms are not required, however matching uniforms are recommended.

TRAINING FACILITIES

Practice will be possible outside of canoe/kayak and rowing competition times and warm up outside lines before. Starting gates practice is available before competition.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Planning for the EMG2023 competition will continue throughout 2022 and spring 2023. Additional sport specific information will be communicated to registered participants and this Sports Information Guide will be updated according to possible changes.
