# **COMPETITION SPORTS AND DISCIPLINES**

The age categories for Karate at EMG2023 are as follows:

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group. For the Games, your age is determined as at 31 December 2023.

The weight categories for Kumite at EMG2023 are:

• Female: -50kg, - 55kg, -61kg, -68kg, +68kg

• Male: -60kg, -67kg, -75kg, -84kg, -94kg, +94kg

If there are insufficient number of entries in an age or a weight category, categories may be combined in order to conduct a good quality competition. The awarding of medals will not be affected, meaning that individuals will still be awarded medals in the age category in which they originally entered.

# **COMPETITION DETAILS**

### Competition rules

WKF kata. Different kata are required for each round. For kumite, current WKF rules apply. With following exceptions:

- two minutes bouts
- only skin touch to the head.

### **Competition format**



Kata: WKF format

Kumite: elimination or round robin depending on the number of athletes.

#### Medals

In European Masters Games, the athletes do not represent their country of origin, therefore the prize-awarding ceremonies will be carried out without hoisting of flags. No National Anthem of the winning team will be played. The medals will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

### **Technical meeting**

A Technical Meeting will take place before the start of the competitions in order to introduce the competitions, remind those involved of the regulations and the behavior that is expected.

#### Personal accident insurance and medical certificate

It is the participant's own responsibility to take out adequate and valid accident and health insurance. The competitor registration fee does not cover personal accident insurance.

#### Anti-doping

The IMGA has adopted an anti-doping policy in line with the WADA (World Anti-Doping Agency) code, which means that testing will be conducted during the games.
